





5 months ago, when we started working on the second issue, a lot of words came to our mind. One of them was "fight".



I am interested to know how you integrate and combine your interests - illustration, drawing, collage making and fashion- in your work, how do they compliment each other? It is definitely a really interesting combination.

P-L.A. For now I would say I still have a lot of work to do on this! What is good about being a student is that you have to produce 2D portfolios of work so it is easy to combine both, if you do it well, one is always going to reflect the other! But this year for my final collection what people will see will be the clothes only first, it is going to be harder.









Also, how does being in SPTRL. an art and fashion school such as CSM influence your work?

It really helps with the re- P-L.A. search. You have access to all sorts of medias, books and magazines archives mind-blowing. It's so rich and so that is great. Also everyone is well put together. so good at what they do and you can see the work of students in different pathways, the variety of work really pushes you to produce your own very best!

Tell us about your creative process, where do you get ideas from, how you develop them and bring them to life.

P-L.A. It depends what I am working on. When I am doing collages, I start sculpting with Zbrush (software) and my tablet from a basic bust and sometimes I use pictures for references. When it comes to illustration I just draw from scratch, basically. For designing it is way more work, I always do research from magazines scans, books, build a sketchbook and start toiling-that is what we're taught in school. It is a great way to work. Without it, it never feels really complete. The only problem I have is that I struggle to focus on something for an extended period of time, so I always kind of disconnect half way through the process. It happens with everything!


pronounced himself about the issue. Without taking it further, how do you think this has had an impact on you and your career?

Also I noticed how people have started tackling these issues on social media much more in the past few months, which is a positive point. I am glad that it raised awareness on the subject.

You received a lot of support from your school, CSM, which took the opportunity to make a statement on a very controversial issue: how big brands benefit from young artists or creatives' work without even crediting or paying them. Could you roughly tell us about your opinion on this?
